### CHILDREN'S CORNER- The Last Sunday after Epiphany

Today in:

**Children's Chapel-** After reading today's gospel, the children learn about Jesus and his friends, when they all go up the mountain and Jesus is changed before their eyes.

**Weaving God's Promises** (pre-K through 6<sup>th</sup> grade) – Today, the children learn about the reaction of the people as Jesus does signs and miracles.

**Rite 13-** The students will continue to discuss how God helps us to experience divine compassion and mercy, and about how we, as Christians, can practice compassion and mercy in our daily lives.

**Keeping it Real and Relevant/J2A-** The students will discuss the Gospel reading, centering on what the transfiguration tells us about Jesus. What do we learn about Jesus
