#### Today in:

**Children's Chapel-** After reading today's gospel, the children learn about Jesus going into the desert to be tested for 40 days, and how, after that, he was helped by the angels. The children will explore this story in light of the help God gives us when we are in our wilderness times.

Weaving God's Promises (pre-K through  $6^{th}$  grade) – Today, the children learn about why we keep Lent, and some practices we use to keep a holy Lent. We will meet in the church immediately after service.

**Rite 13-** students will continue to talk about God's Compassion and Mercy, and in keeping with this lesson, they will spend a portion of the hour baking in preparation for their field trip:
