CHOIRMASTER’S NOTES:

Today’s anthem, “O day of peace that dimly shines,” is actually Hymn 597 in our Episcopal *Hymnal 1982*. Sir Hubert Parry composed this popular British tune, entitled *Jerusalem*, as a musical setting for William Blake’s iconic poem of the same title. Blake’s poem begins “And did those feet in ancient time Walk upon England’s mountains green: And was the holy Lamb of God, On England’s pleasant pastures seen!” This poem was based on the legend of the young Jesus traveling with Joseph of Arimathea to England. Given its apocryphal “theology,” Blake’s poem is not suitable for our American

Episcopal hymnal, but we are fortunate to be able to sing this majestic tune with an alternative poem by Carl P. Daw, Jr. If the music is unfamiliar, please follow along as best you can in the blue hymnal because we will be singing it as a congregational hymn later this summer.
