Children's Chapel is available for children ages pre-k through 3rd grade during the 10am worship service on the 2nd floor of the Education Building.

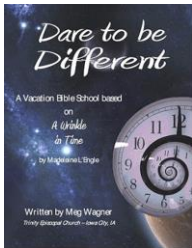


If your younger children are staying with you in the pew during service, we are delighted to have the whole family joining us in worship.
