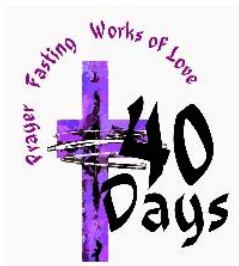

Living Compass Lent Study

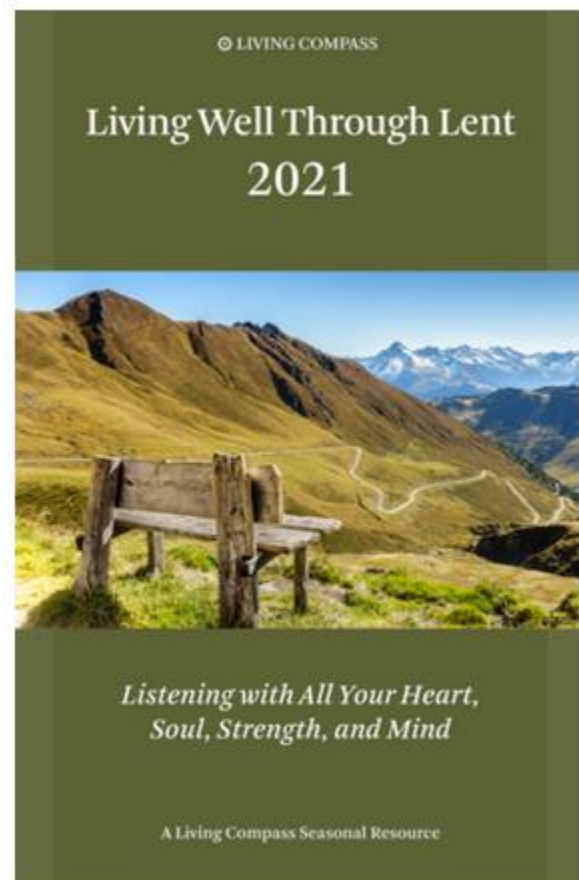
