Living Compass Lent Study

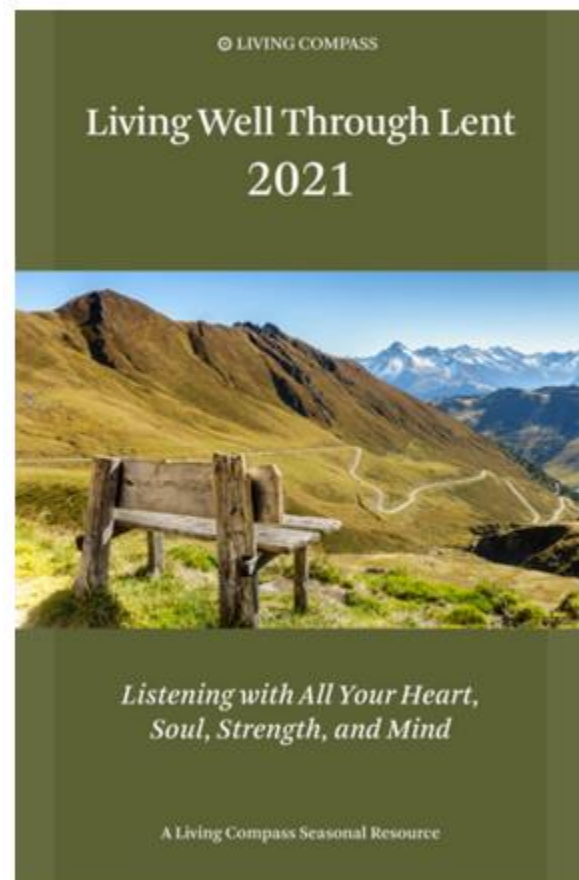

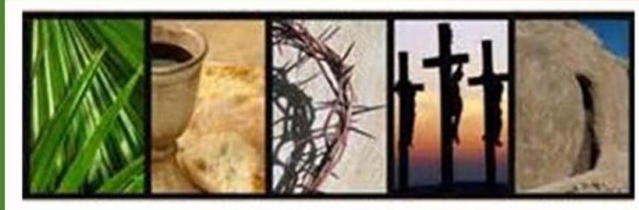

Drop it off on Berry campus.

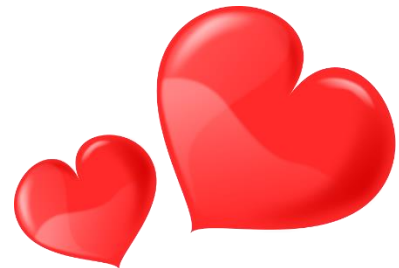
In the past, cooks have usually provided a simple main dish (like chili or vegetarian lasagna), a salad, and dessert.
