From the Rector's Desk

February 22, 2021

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the weekend, the Diocese of Atlanta informed me that they have officially accepted Fr. Jorge's resignation as Vicar. Fr. Jorge will be moving to the Diocese of Puerto Rico to serve as Priest in Charge at La Natividad de Nuestra Senor on Culebra Island. The Rev. Gregoria Betances will serve as an interim Vicar for the coming months until the Diocese finds another Hispanic Vicar to come to Rome and continue the good work already begun here at St. Peter's. Mother Betances begins on March 1st 2021.

We are grateful for the work Fr. Jorge has done for St. Peter's and the Hispanic community while here in Rome. Fr. Jorge took our mission from a weekly average attendance of about 5 people to over 50 in less than a year, and would sometimes see in excess of over 100 people in the pews for the Hispanic service. Under his watch, 27 people were confirmed or received into this communion on All Saint's Sunday in 2019, a testament to his great work. Father Jorge is a gifted priest.
