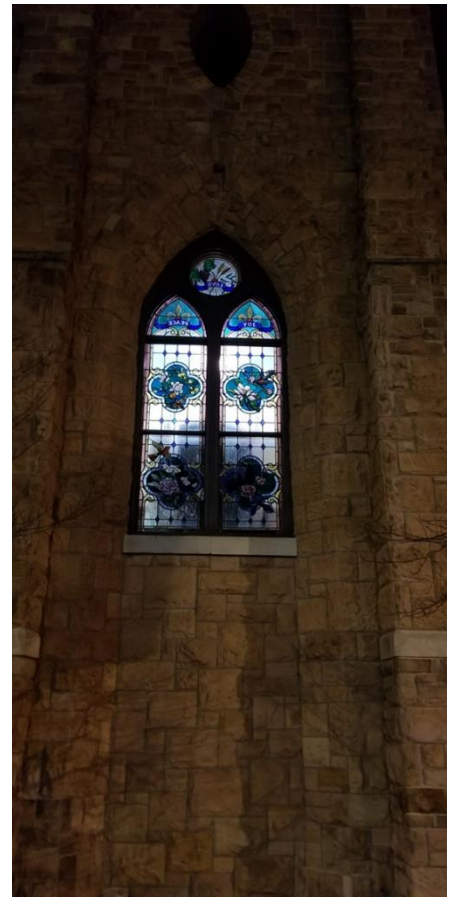
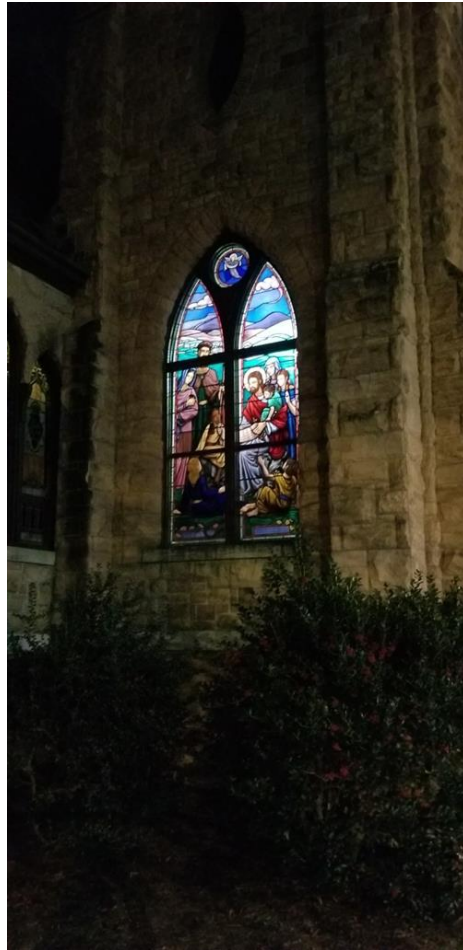
LENT BAGS – will be available for pickup on Wednesday Morning. These bags will contain blessed ashes, prayers, and devotional materials.
