Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

By now you have likely received word that the Bishop has moved to allow indoor services of worship throughout the Diocese. The regathering team of Dr. Gary Voccio, Dr. John Kirkland, Dr. David Carlton, Jennifer Bressette, Nat Massey, Jan Routledge, Lynette Bonner and I met on Zoom last night to discuss this exciting news.

We will allow for some time to develop between the broadening of vaccinations to the public and our first service to take place. The regathering team suggested two weeks from Monday March the 15th as a good amount of time to allow for this to take place. The first Sunday after this time frame is Easter Sunday. **Therefore, Easter Sunday will be our first indoor/in-person service of worship.**

There are still protocols in place that we must observe, and indoor seating will be limited based on those protocols. However, this is a significant milestone, and it is worth celebrating. In addition, we will be able to expand our outdoor services of worship to 75 people, again with protocols in place. Several participants of the regathering team and I will be working out the logistics and spacing in the church and on our campus in order to make this work well. When that is completed, we will get more details to you. But, in the meantime rejoice and celebrate. Better days are ahead.
