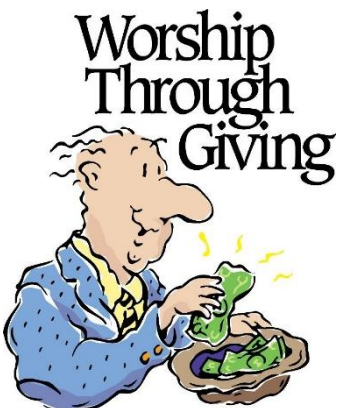
Campus Missioner Job Opening

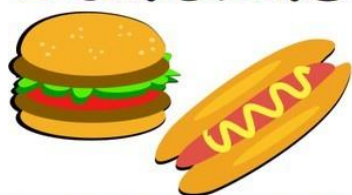
