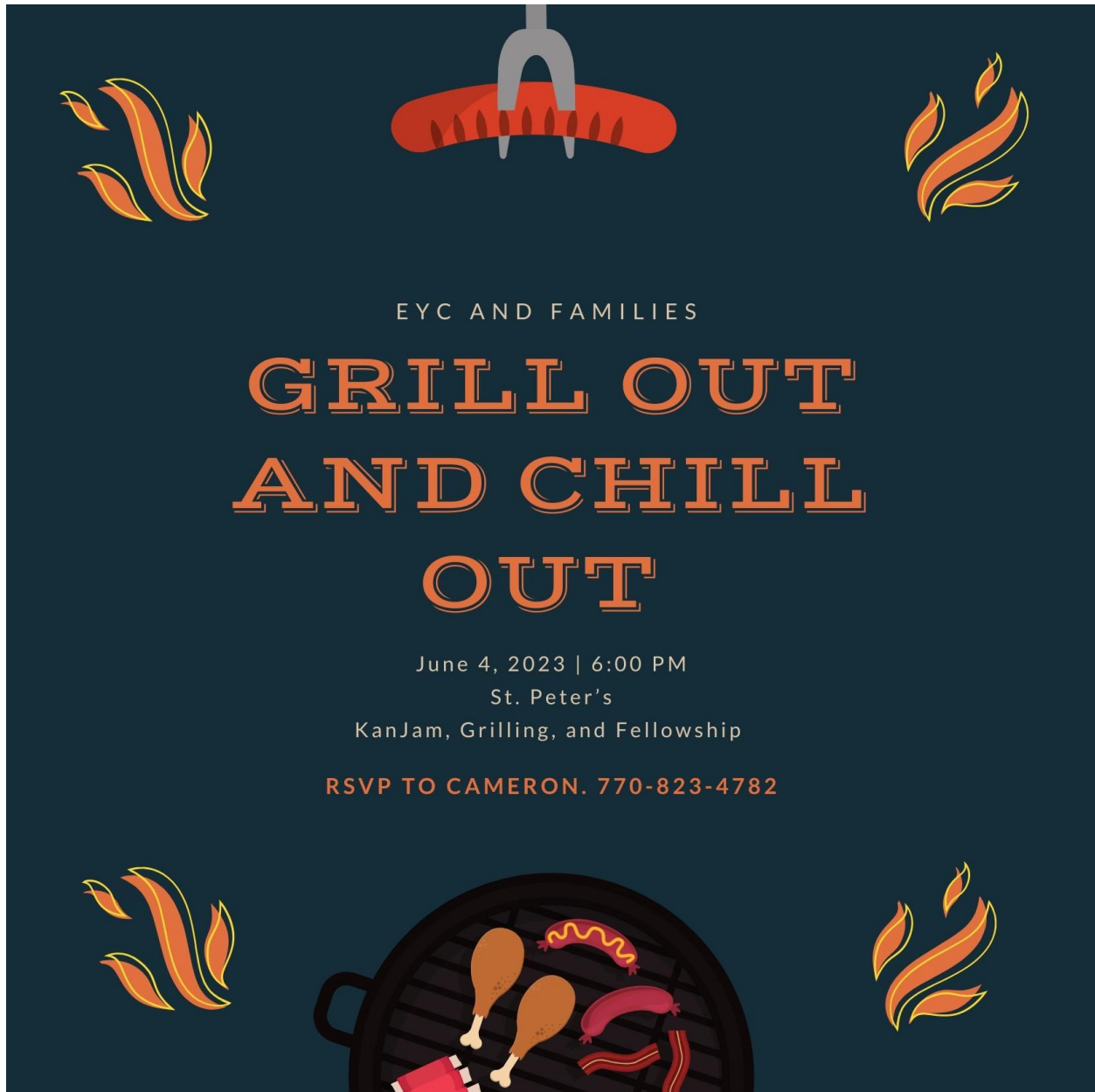

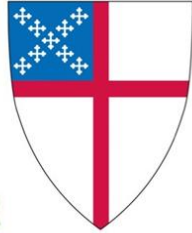

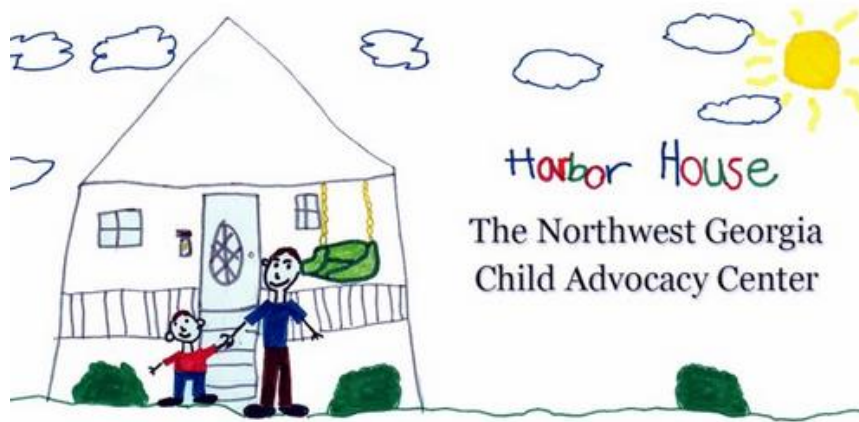

If you have an interest, please come. **We need you!!**

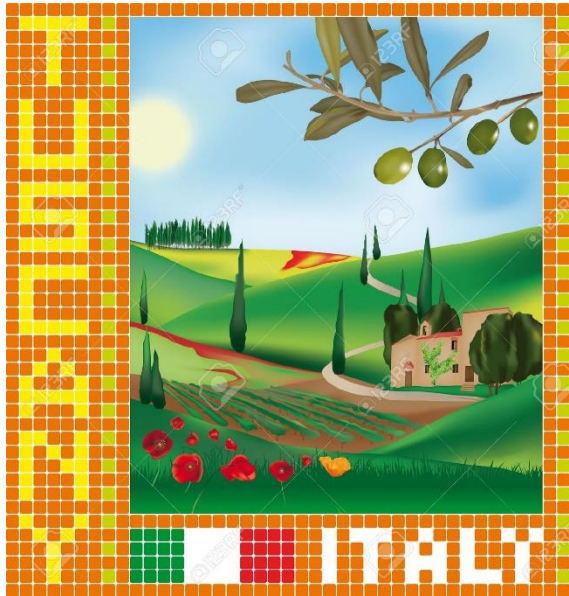
