

Parish bylaws require that there be at least one nominee for each vacant position.

You must receive the consent of the potential candidate prior to submitting her/his name.

Those qualified for election to the office of Vestry Member must align with the following guidelines:

Any confirmed communicant in good standing of the Parish who is not less than 18 years of age, is a regular attendant at the services of the Church in the proceeding election and is know by the Treasurer to have made and fulfilled a stated financial commitment for the church support in the year proceeding election.

Please note that the new bylaws do not permit nominations from the floor because candidates must be vetted against the above requirements prior to nomination.


Please be certain to have all transactions **COMPLETED** by **December 29**th in order for that gift to appear on your 2023 giving statement.
