## Meals for our Shelters

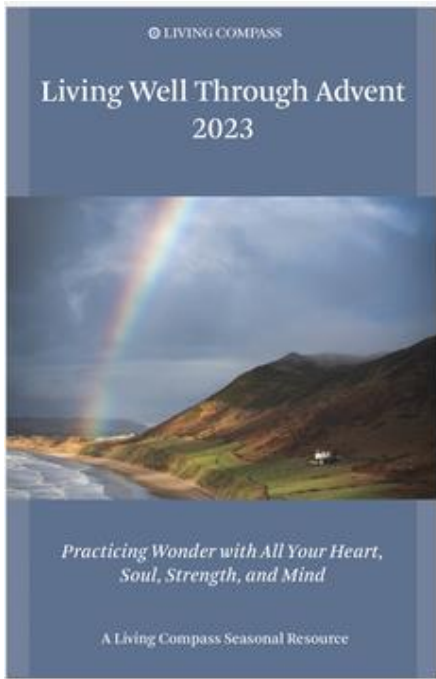
We have a lovely loyal group of volunteers that provide and deliver a dinner meal to each of the homeless shelters once a month.
