- **Adults considering Reception or Re-Affirmation.**



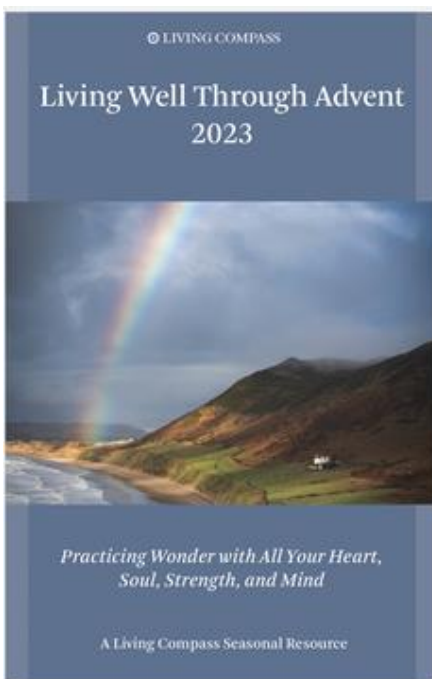
## Meals for our Shelters

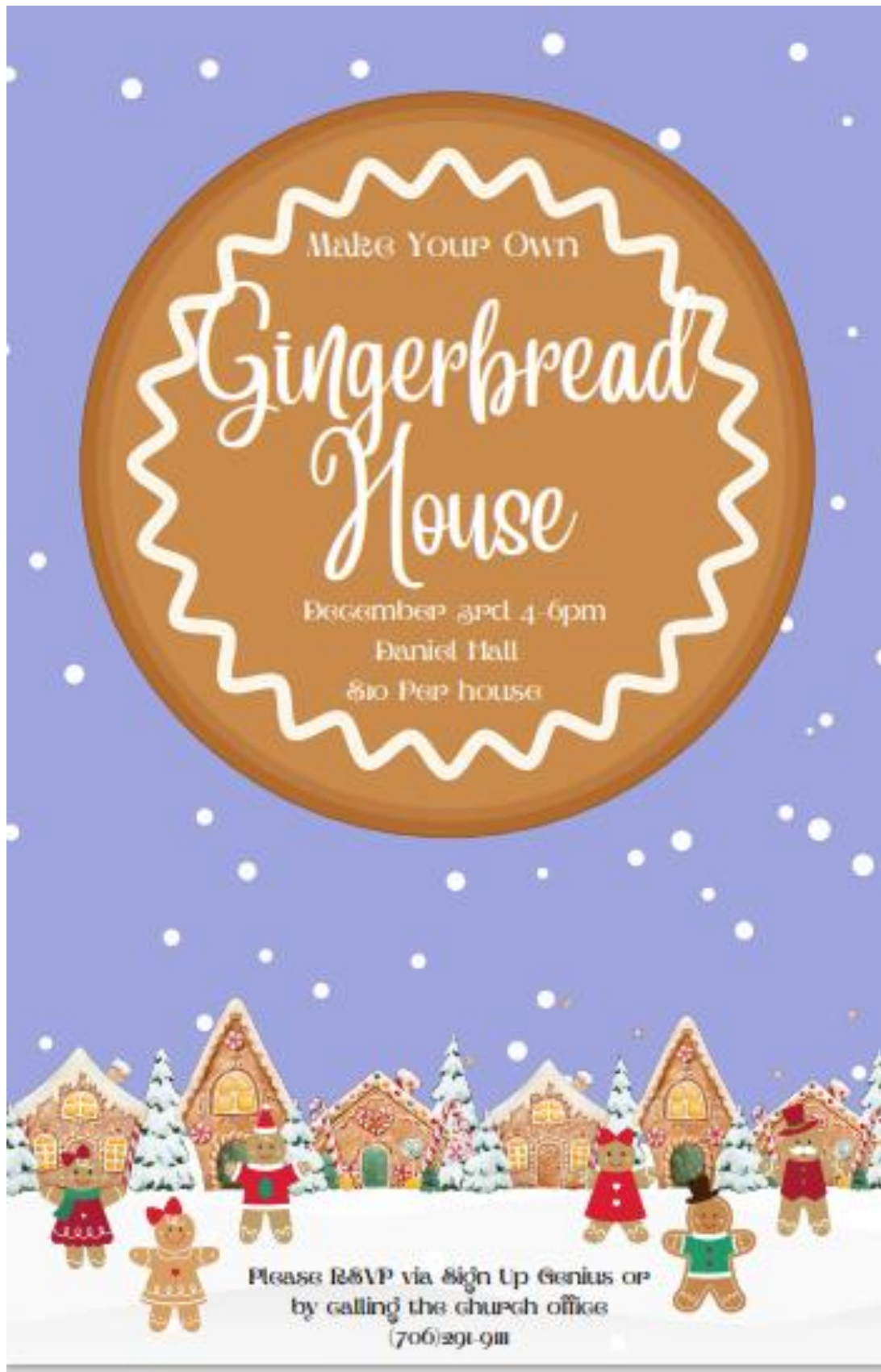
