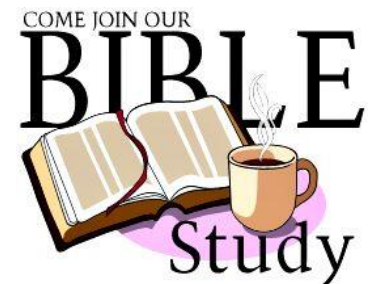

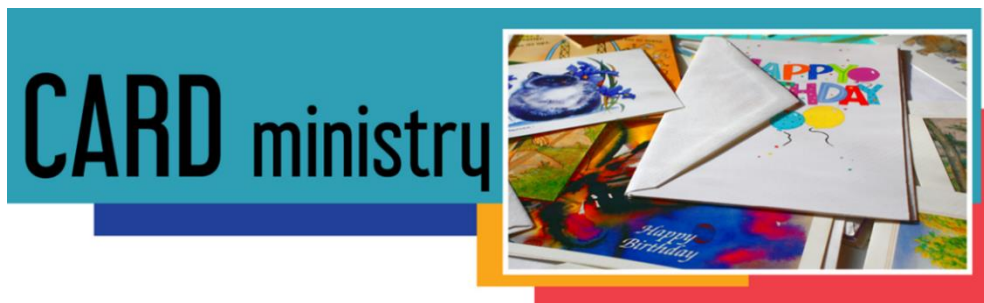

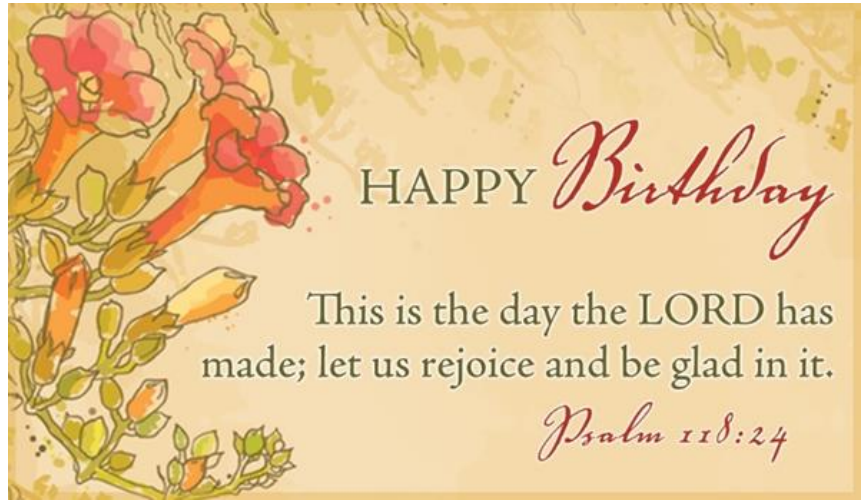

## How Can I Volunteer for Children's Ministries?

### **ROOTS**

Roots is held two Sunday's a month, right after Children's Choir, at 4:30-5:30pm. Roots offers a safe and welcoming space for our younger members to grow in their faith.

#### How can I help?

In Roots we have the best problem: WE'RE GROWING!  
Since the number of kids are increasing, we are in need of more adult volunteers!

#### What roles are there?

- Story Teller- This person will be responsible for leading the kids through the corresponding Bible Story of the day.
- Craft Leader- This person will be responsible for planning a craft that goes with the story that engages the children.
- Snack Leader- This person will be responsible for planning and setting up snacks for the children attending Roots.

### **CHILDREN'S CHAPEL**

Children's chapel is every Sunday during the school year (not including Christmas and Easter) where the children will hear a version of the corresponding gospel reading and will be encouraged to connect to it with crafts and games.

#### How can I help?

We are always looking for more people who are interested in leading Children's Chapel!

#### What roles are there?

- Story Teller- Story Teller will lead the kids through the bulletin and the telling of the gospel.
