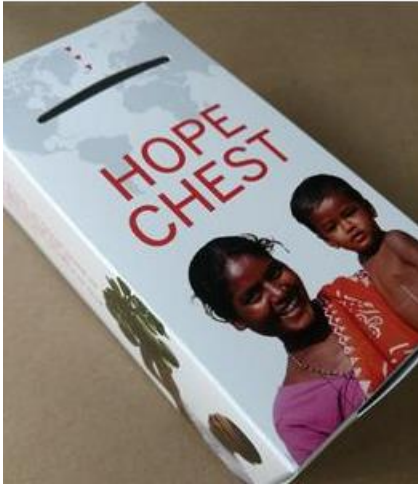

### **ROOTS**

#### How can I help?

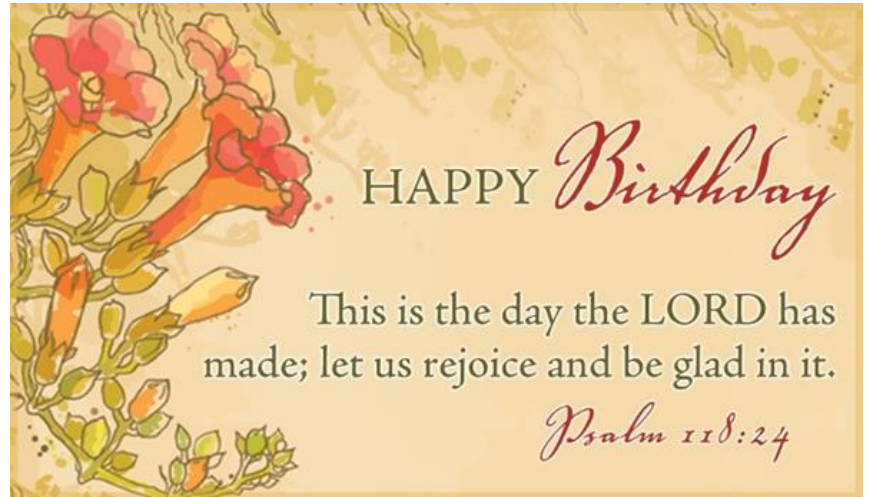

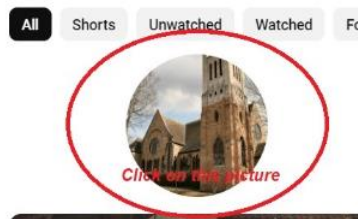
