


#### FACE TO FACE APPOINTMENTS







#### WHY join Realm?



Realm is a cloud-based program that St. Peter's uses to track contact information, giving, and activities of the Parish.

Those that join Realm can access their personal contact & giving information. Also, able to see all activities of the Parish.

The church office controls who receives a Realm Invitation. The site and information are NOT public.

- Set it and forget it establish automatic giving using your checking account or a credit card. You set the amount, frequency, and source of funds.
- Register for events easy RSVP for events like Wednesday night meals, VBS, etc.
- Communication preferences YOU set the device you prefer to receive church communications through i.e. email or text.
- Groups If you are a member or leader of a group at St. Peter's like Altar Guild you can easily communicate with other members without having to maintain a separate contact list. Realm knows who a member of which group is and chatting or emailing back and forth is very easy.
- Download the App to your ios or android phone

If you want to Join, simply contact the church office and they will send you an emailed invite.
