FROM THE DESK OF THE RECTOR

Dear People of St. Peter's,

Over the past two plus years, the Vestry has investigated and studied the need to repair or replace our nave roof. Because addressing our nave roof is impossible without disturbing the asbestos shingles, and we cannot pull those shingles and then put them back, we are going to proceed with replacing the nave roof. The best window of opportunity for that work is in August of this year. Allien McNair and I will have a presentation about the roof replacement in the near future.

In addition, the Vestry has identified other strategic priorities for program and capital improvements at St. Peter's. Through a parishwide study in April, May, and June, we will test the feasibility of funding those priorities. We ask everyone to participate in this process to help ensure the study's success. When the study is completed, there will be more information forth coming about a campaign for the roof and any other strategic improvements our parish supports.


The Nursery will be available on Maundy Thursday and Easter Sunday for both services from 8:15-11:45am

Throughout the history of mankind, music has been a vehicle for expressing all aspects of human experienced emotions. It has been used to spread news as well as to document events.

During the 20th century, the advances in technology reduced the need to use music to announce an army or spread news.

However, during the years of the Holocaust, song literature was needed to fulfill the unique needs of people caught in an unimaginable nightmare. Yaakov Rotenberg, who was confined to the Lodz ghetto, explained: "These songs reflect the everday reality. They served in place of newspapers, radios and other forms of entertainment."

This presentation, which is a combination of lecture, images, and song is meant to educate, remind, and to fulfill the obligation to "Never Forget."
