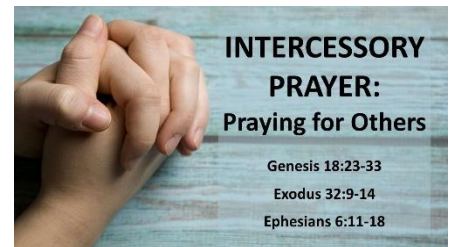

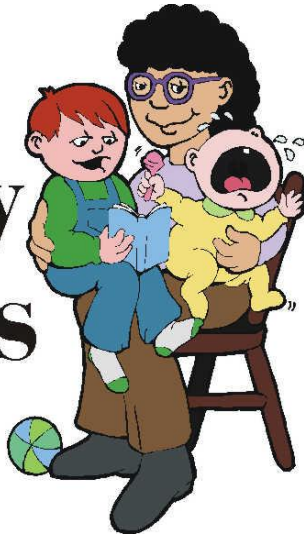

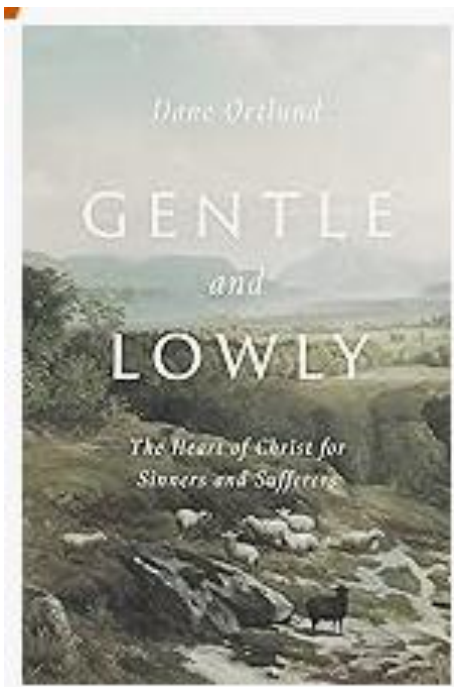

July 25


Father David helped us choose it so it's bound to be good! We will have a study guide to follow.

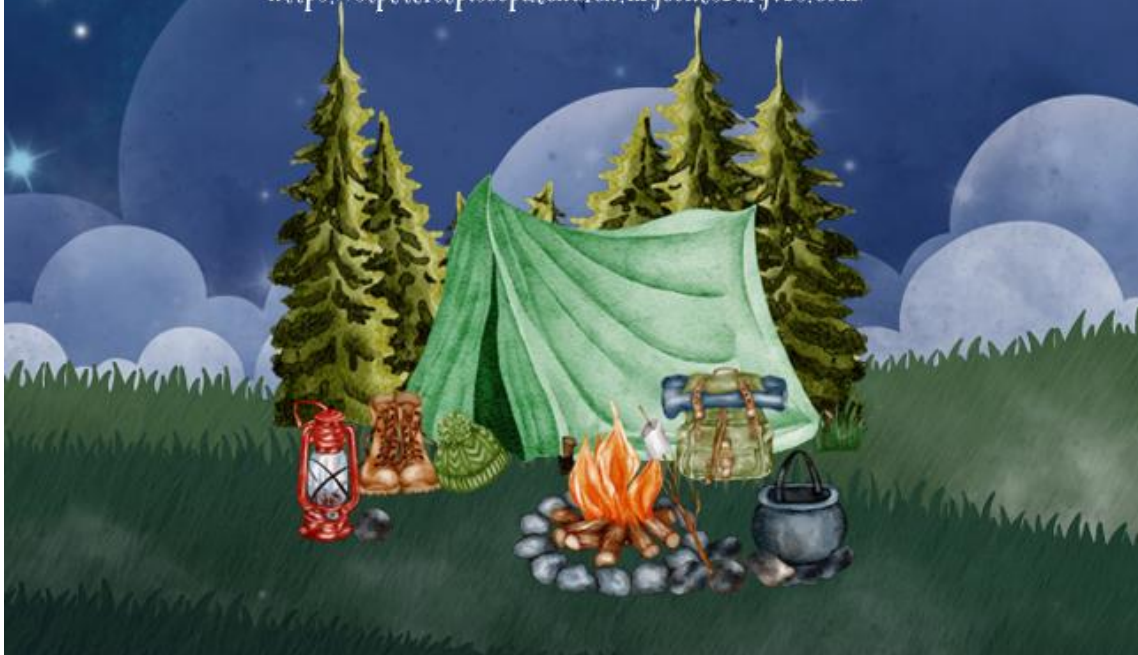
