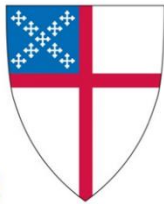

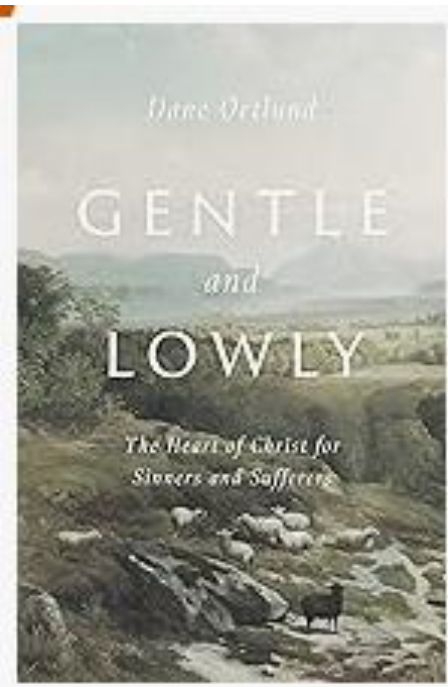


Tired of writing checks or the delay in mailing checks to remit your pledge or church tithe?

Electronic ways to remit payment to St. Peter's include:

- **Join Realm** set up remittance using a credit or debit card. You can set the remittance to be automatic or trigger the payment when you want. No stamps or cost of writing a check.
- **Bank Draft** use YOUR personal checking account and set up a payment schedule using your auto bill pay feature. Your bank will cut the check and mail it directly to St. Peter's.
- **PayPal** use the church website and remit through Paypal using a credit or debit card.

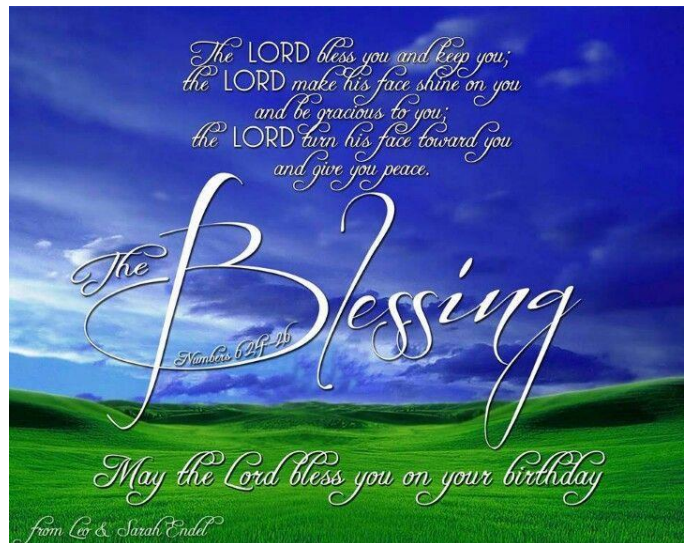
