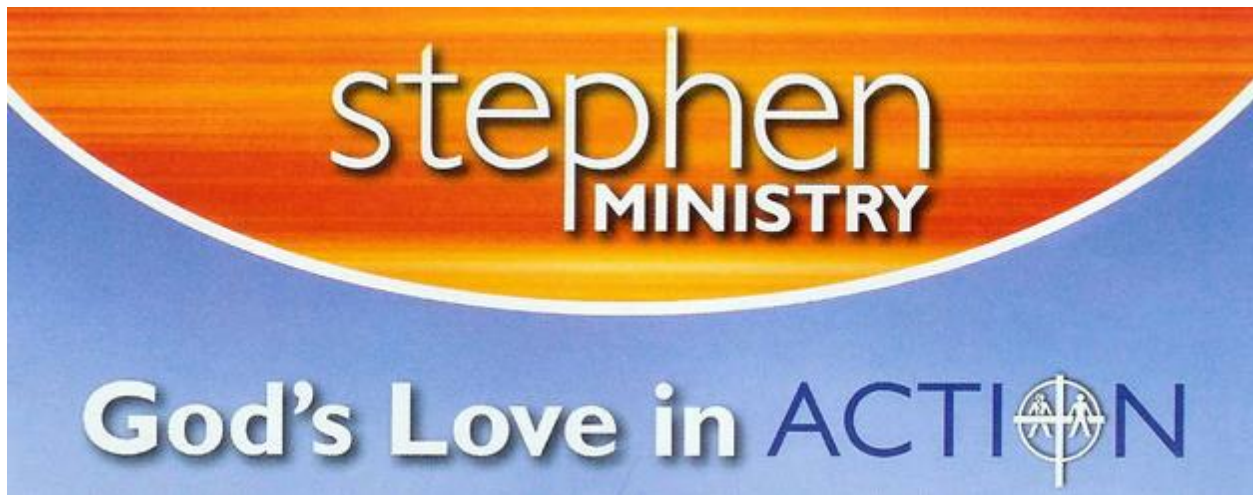

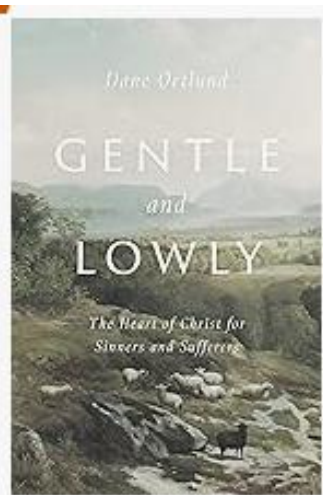

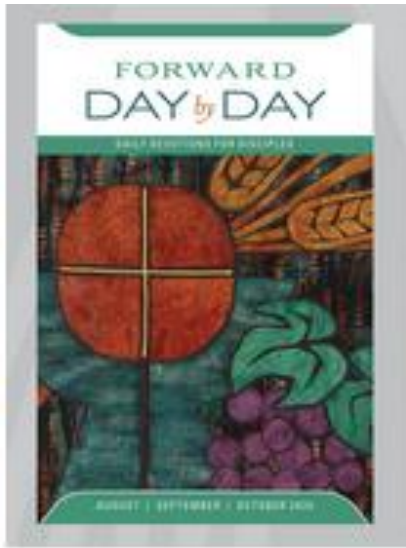
Summer Book Study

HOWEVER, if you are not able to work the full 3 hours, any time you can share is greatly appreciated!

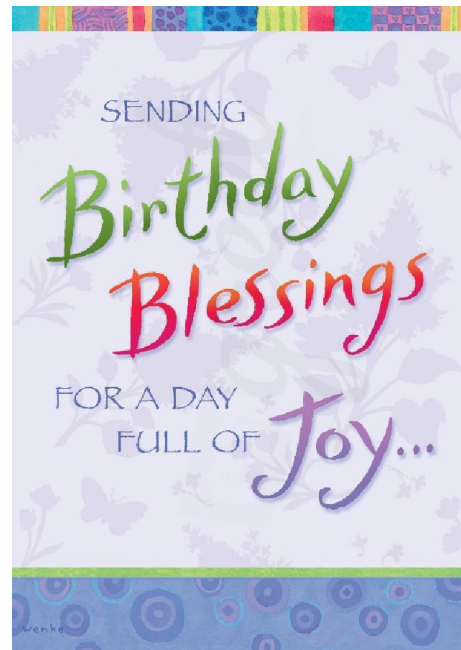
