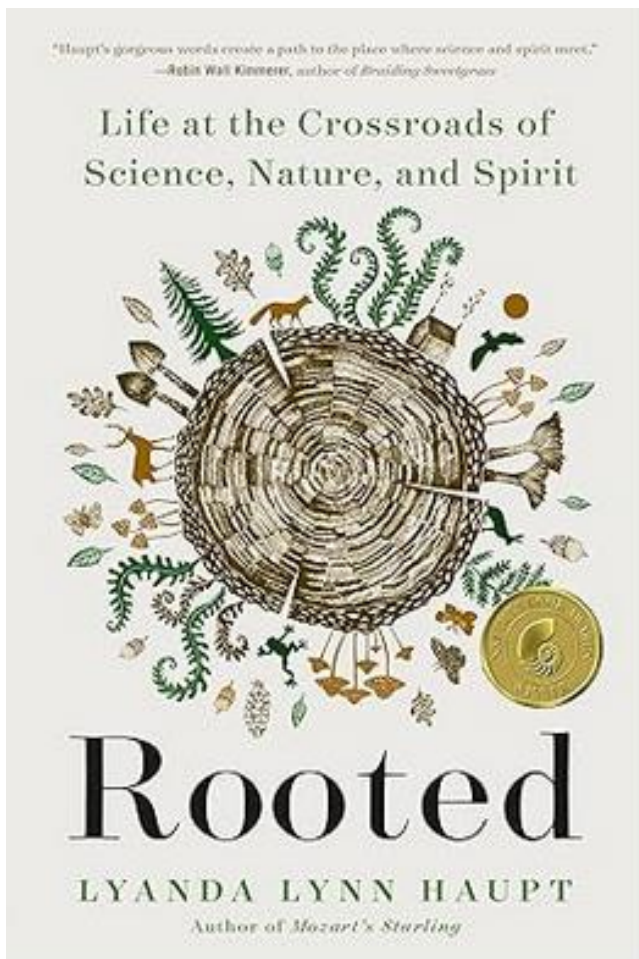

### New Menu Idea:

- Adult Meal would include 1 protein, 2 veggies, bread, dessert. You PICK your protein & veggies.
- Children's Meal would also offer two options along with appropriate kid sides.

### **Sample ADULT menus might be:**

Fried Chicken or Meatloaf – pick 1 protein

Mashed potatoes, Green beans, Buttered corn, Tossed salad – pick 2 veggies

Pan Seared catfish or Bacon Wrapped Pork Tenderloin – pick 1 protein

Cheese grits, broccoli casserole, white beans, coleslaw – pick 2 veggies.

Hawaiian Chicken or Cabbage Roll – pick 1 protein

Yellow Rice, Garlic green beans, Pickled beets, Tossed Salad – pick 2 veggies.

To make a viable online directory available to those that utilize the convenience of REALM there are some changes coming next week.

You do NOT need to do anything. This is simply a heads up that you will receive an email(s) when these changes are made.

Here is what is changing:

- Everyone in the church database will have their status changed to OPT IN for the online directory.
- Everyone in the database will also have their contact information (phone, email, address) also visible in the on-line directory. Just like in a paper directory.

Your privacy is secure.

No one can access the Realm online directory that has NOT been personally INVITED to join Realm. Invitations are extended to “members” only and are initiated by the church office.

These changes allow those that utilize Realm on their phone or desktop to have a parish directory at their fingertips.

HOWEVER, if you are not able to work the full 3 hours, any time you can share is greatly appreciated!

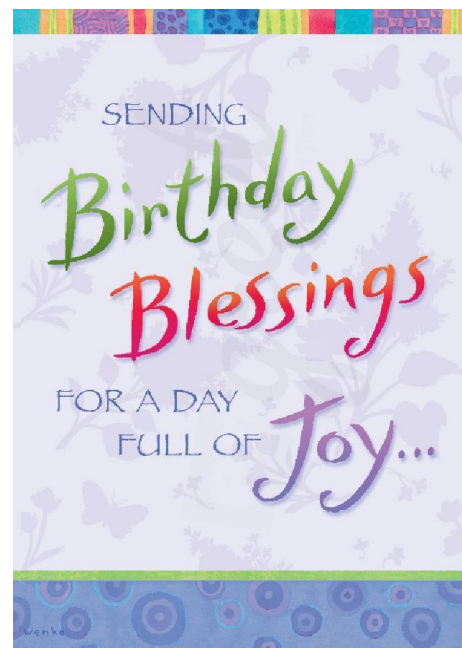
