Sympathy of the Parish extended to the Virden family on the death of Bob Malone, brother-in-law to Stan Virden.

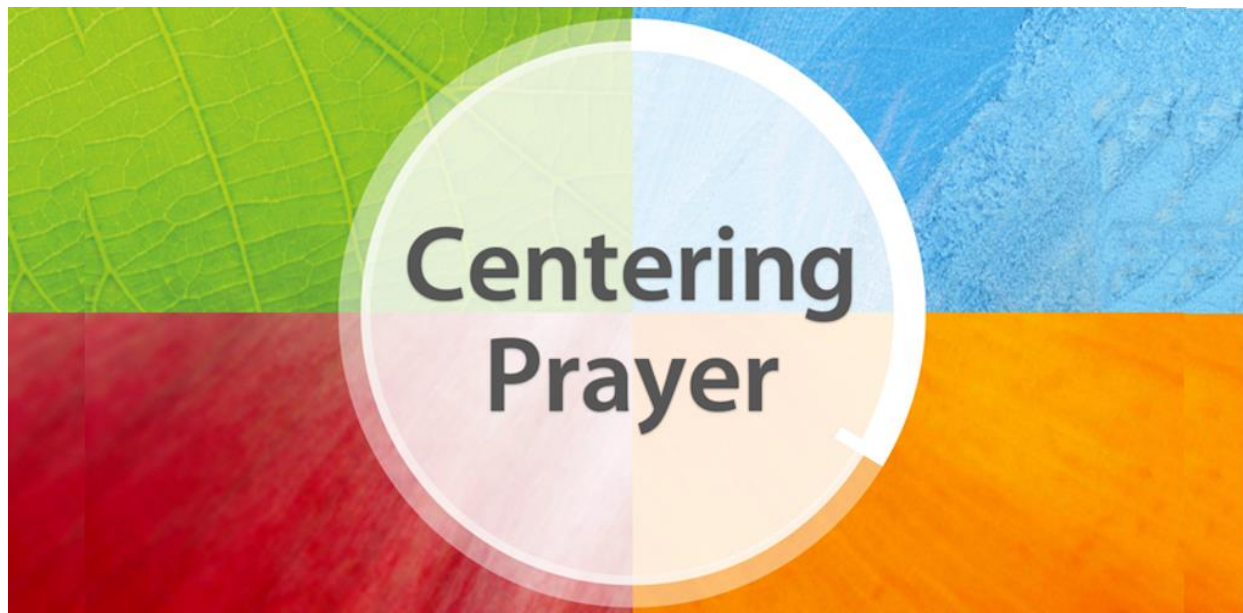

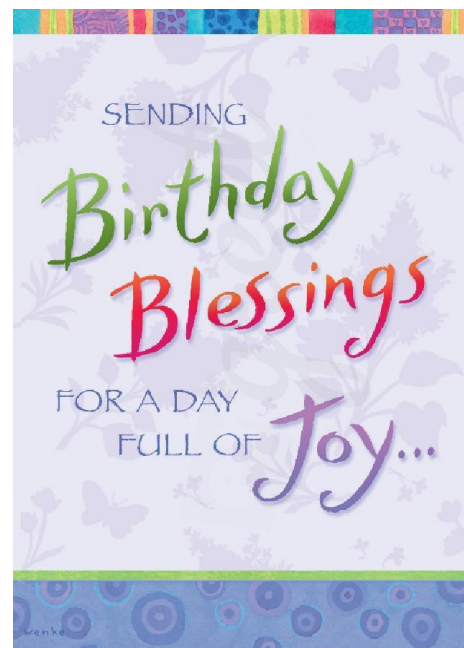
ROOTS returns...

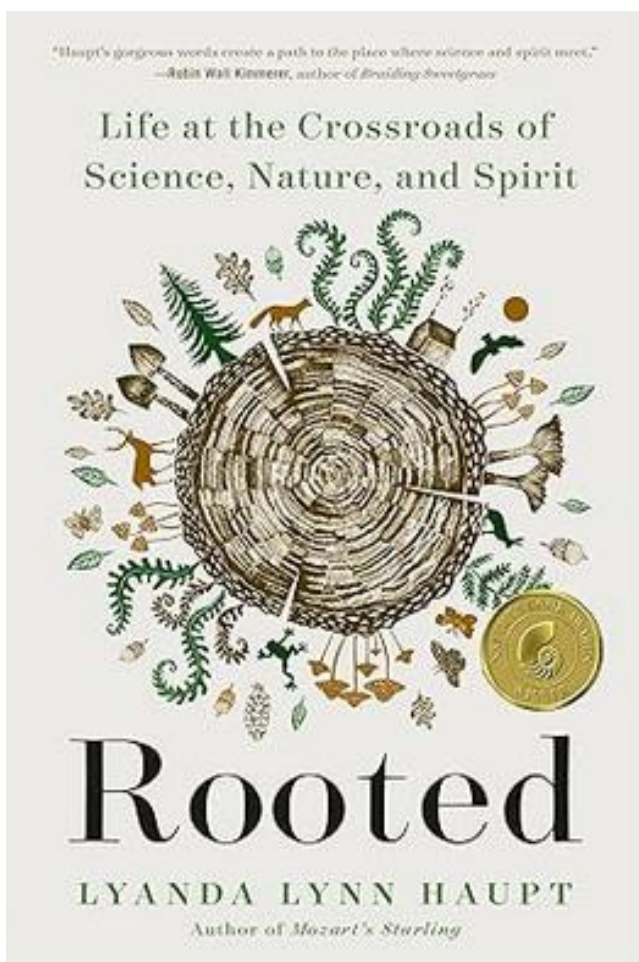
