




Kid Size Worship for ages 3-7, who can sit for a short service.


Children depart as a group from the nave at 9:57am. Returning at the Peace to share the Eucharist with their families.

Who's Involved in Stephen Ministry?



Stephen Leaders can be church staff or members who have been trained to provide ongoing leadership for their congregation's Stephen Ministry.

Stephen
Ministers are
congregation
members trained by

their Stephen Leaders to offer care to people who are hurting. A Stephen Minister typically has one care receiver at a time and meets with that person once a week for about an hour.

Care receivers are individuals in the congregation who are going through a crisis or life difficulty. Potential care receivers first meet with a pastor or Stephen Leader, who assesses their needs for care and matches them with a Stephen Minister. The caring relationship lasts for as long as the need persists.
