### **Who's Involved in Stephen Ministry?**



**Stephen Leaders can be church staff or members who have been trained to provide ongoing leadership for their congregation's Stephen Ministry.**

**Stephen Ministers are congregation members trained by**

**their Stephen Leaders to offer care to people who are hurting. A Stephen Minister typically has one care receiver at a time and meets with that person once a week for about an hour.**

**Care receivers are individuals in the congregation who are going through a crisis or life difficulty. Potential care receivers first meet with a pastor or Stephen Leader, who assesses their needs for care and matches them with a Stephen Minister. The caring relationship lasts for as long as the need persists.**
