




Everyday Spiritual Practices: Baptismal Life Amid the Routines

Our recently completed prayer shawls received a blessing during the 10 am. service a few weeks ago.

Now what?

- Anyone can deliver a prayer shawl to a friend or relative that you feel would benefit from such a gift.
- Follow the process below to ensure accurate tracking.
- 1. Call the office or stop by during posted hours and ask for a shawl. The name of the person who delivers it as well as the name of the recipient will be marked on the Prayer Shawl Log.
- 2. If you are a Eucharistic Visitor, Flower Deliverer, member of a Loaves and Fishes team or anyone who routinely visits shut-ins or members who have experienced a loss or trauma you are always encouraged to take a prayer shawl.
- 3. Members of the staff or clergy will sometimes also be delivering prayer shawls as part of their usual visits to members who are home bound or in need of their presence.

These prayer shawls were made for the expressed purpose of being given away so please help us make them fly off the shelves.
