CALL FOR VESTRY CANDIDATE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Annual Parish Meeting will be held in Daniel Hall on **Sunday, November 10, 2024 following the 10:00 am service**. **T h r e e** new vestry members will be elected at this time to replace the four retiring members. Please remember that the Canons of the Episcopal Diocese of Atlanta do not permit absentee ballots at the Annual Meeting. You must be present to vote.

Parish by-laws require that there be at least one nominee for each vacant position. Once the Nominating Committee has a complete list of names and is assured that each potential nominee meets the qualifications, the Committee then prayerfully selects a slate of candidates that endeavor to continue a balance of gender, skills, age and length of time at St. Peter's.

If you have a potential candidate(s) you wish to recommend, please submit your recommendation(s) in writing -- by email (dasmyth0521@gmail.com – to a member of the Vestry Nominating Committee ***no later than 25th***. You must receive the consent of the potential candidate prior to submitting their name to the nominating committee.

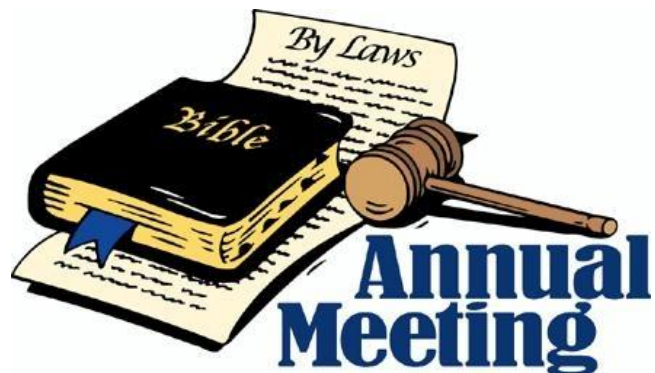

Those qualified for election to the office of Vestry Member is as follows: Any confirmed communicant in good standing of the Parish who is not less than eighteen years of age, is a regular attendant at the services of the Church in the year preceding election and is known by the Treasurer to have made and fulfilled a stated financial commitment for church support in the year preceding election.

Please note that the new bylaws do not permit nominations from the floor because candidates must be vetted against the above requirements prior to nomination. If you wish to suggest a candidate, you must submit a written recommendation to a member of the Nominating Committee by no later than October 27.

Greetings! I am writing to share with you the news that The Rev. David Boyd, affectionately known here as Father David, has accepted a call to be a Canon of Pastoral Care at St. Philips in Atlanta, known by most as “The Cathedral”.

This is exciting news for David. Much like Lou Holz would only leave his coaching position at Minnesota if Notre Dame ever came calling, Father David had no intention of leaving St. Peter’s for anyplace, with the lone exception being St. Philips. A place of which he has dreamed of doing ministry, since before he was ordained.

David has done great work here at St. Peter’s and is particularly gifted in Pastoral Care and in Preaching. We will miss his talents, and I will miss his daily sense of humor in the confines of the Willingham House. Nonetheless, he will now go to a different parish system so that he may learn new things in a different context and continue to grow until one day he is prepared to accept a call as a Rector in the Episcopal Church.

In due time, we will call a new Associate Rector and raise another priest for the benefit of the wider Church. In addition, plans are in motion to keep the Canterbury Student Ministry in good hands, although I cannot share them yet.

David will preach and celebrate the next two Sundays, and his last Sunday will be October 27th,. We will have a reception in his honor on that day. Until then, feel free to join my in extending congratulations and well wishes to Father David.
