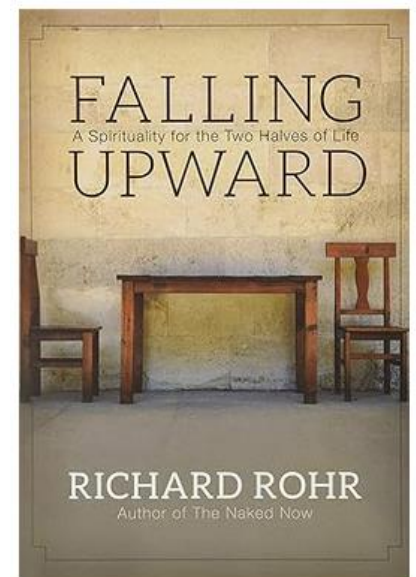
## **MONDAY BOOK GROUP 1PM ~ 401 E. 4<sup>TH</sup> AVE.**

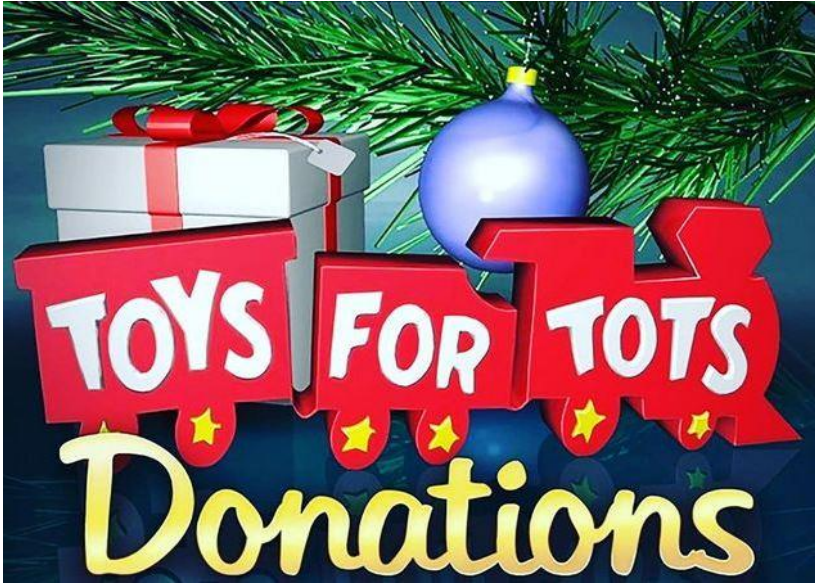

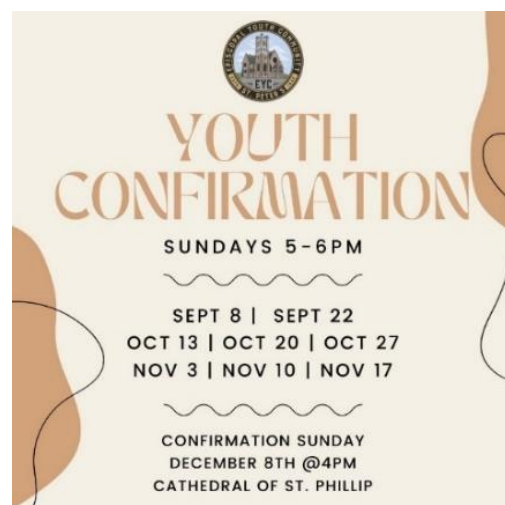

Children depart as a group from the nave at 9:57am for their kid size worship service. Returning to the Nave to share the Eucharist with their families.

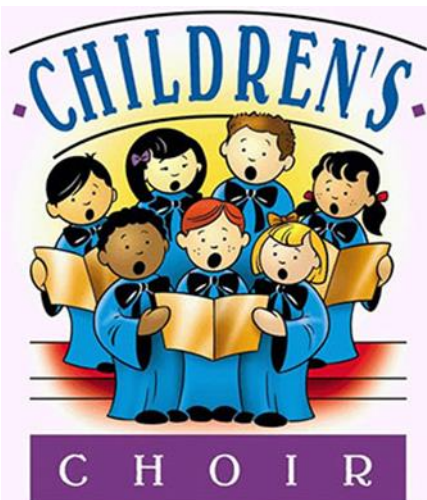
