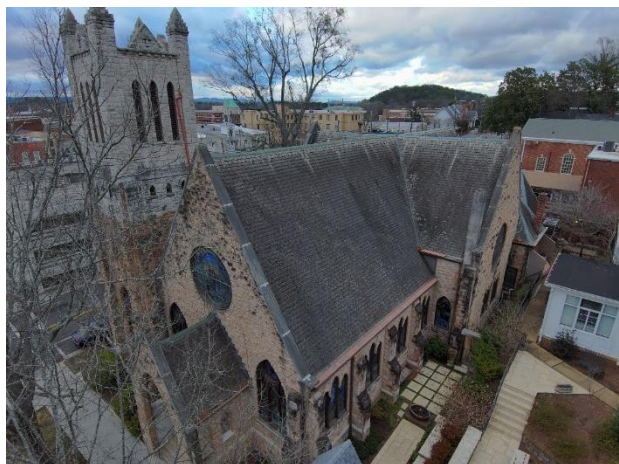

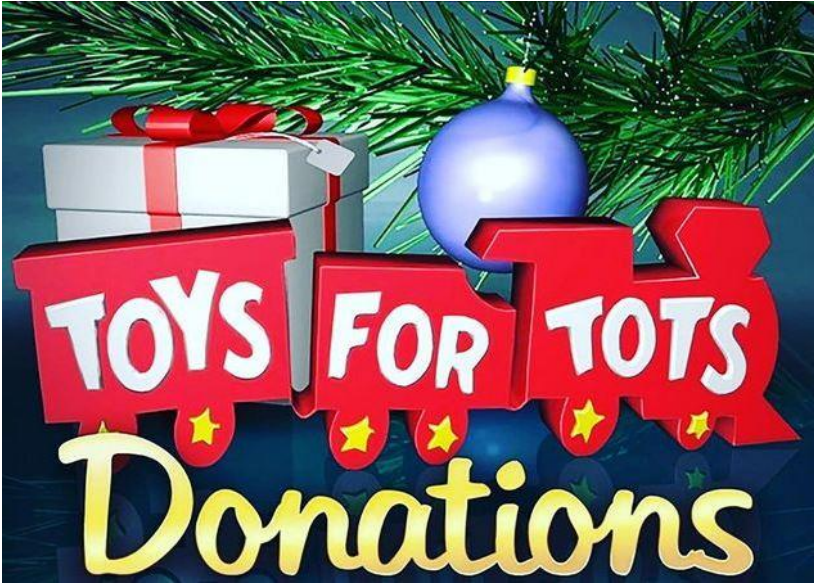

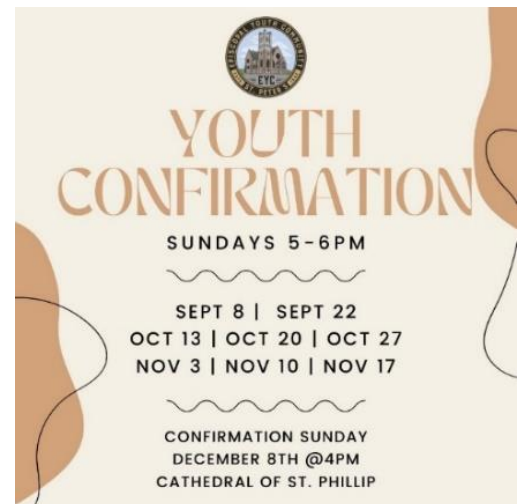

Children depart as a group from the nave at 9:57am for their kid size worship service. Returning to the Nave to share the Eucharist with their families.

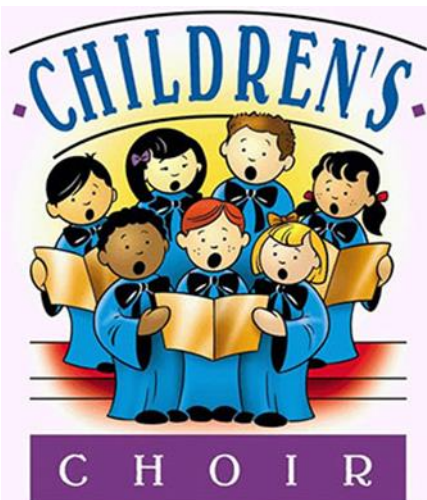
