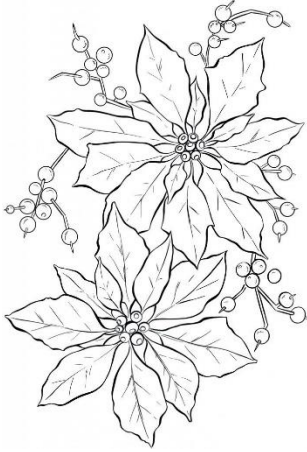
- 1) **Realm** – if you are a member of Realm you can set up electronic giving using your checking account or a credit card. If you are not a member of Realm just call the church office.

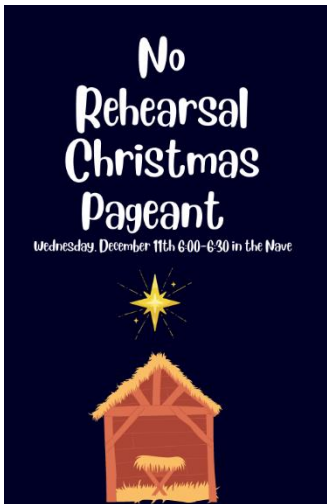
